3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF Grand Prix Target Sprint will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations for ISSF Target Sprint Competition "Edition 2023 – Version 1/2023". Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

Juries will be designated by the Organizing Committee to supervise the Championship. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing according to ISSF Target Sprint Rule 6 and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Entries

ISSF Member Federations entering the Championship must submit the Entries not later than 1st of July 2023. Please complete the Entry Form (Annex 3) and return it by email or fax to the OC.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Entries including entries for the team events. The confirmation must be completed on the day before the open training/ first competition day.

Entry Fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between Venue and official hotels and doping control.

Please transfer all payments not later than 10th of July 3

All amounts must be paid in EUR and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. Take care that all necessary data is transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the correct federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your Team Leader to bring with him / her to the Entry Confirmation.

The Entry Confirmation / Registration will take place at the Venue.

All payments made at the Venue must be paid in cash in EUR (**EUR only**) to the Organizing Committee upon arrival (no credit cards accepted).

Accreditation Process

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Visa

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be send by e-mail. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

Gun License

All nations without the European Firearms Passport (EFP) and all nations who do not belong to the European Union have to be in possession of the approved gun importation form, certified by the respective authorities. Please make sure that you carry along a copy of your certified gun form. Additionally, it is recommended to all delegations to carry a list of all firearms and ammunition with themselves, to be presented to customs or border police upon request together with the invitation.

ATTENTION:

Please do only use the attached Arms and Ammunition Declaration for bringing in firearms and ammunition into the *Country*!

Please fill in the form completely and do not change the form or use your own form! Incomplete Forms cannot be arranged and will be sent back! The forms have to be sent back to the Organizing Committee by fax or email till 1st of July 2023 latest.

You do **not** have to declare **air guns** and the proper ammunition at all, if they conform to the international standard. Please note: To import air guns without an auxiliary permission, they must have the international embossing / stamping "F".



Owners of a **European Firearms Passport (EFP)** may even import their firearms **without** an auxiliary permission to the country.

IMPORTANT:

No guns and ammunition transport are allowed by railway or other public transport facilities!

8. Accommodation

Please book and organize your accommodation via the Dingolfing tourist information office or directly via the hotel portals offered.

Food Service at the Venue

Food and beverages will be available as well at the Venue as at the shooting range.

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel - Arrival

The closest international arrival airport for Dingolfing is Munich (MUN). The distance between Munich airport and Dingolfing is 70 km one way, and it takes about 45 minutes of driving It will be possible to rent a car at Munich airport (MUC).

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

There will be no official Transportation from/to the airport to the official hotels / no local Transportation from the hotels to the Venue offered during the whole competition.

All delegations must inform the *organizing committee* about their arrival and departure details in time.

10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Center / Venue

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on 21st of July 2023 at the Venue.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation should have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Championship.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Entry Deadline.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

It is not allowed to take any arms and ammunition out of the Venue and especially not to the hotel. This law also must be followed strictly by nations that are in the **possession of a European Firearms Passport!!** The armory will be checked every evening to be sure all guns are returned. The armory will be open from 21st of July to the 23rd of July 2023 ONLY!

11. Ceremonies

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the "Venue"

- For the for all single competitions on **Saturday 6 pm.**
- For all Team competitions on **Sunday**, **1pm**.

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations.

12. Weather Information

You may expect minimum temperatures of 23°C in the days and not less than 15°C in the nights. Nevertheless, temperatures in *Dingolfing GER* are very unpredictable, so it could be very hot or rainy and cold. So please be sure to check the weather forecast before your departure to *Dingolfing GER*.
